



Traumatic Brain Injury

Research for Better Understanding

Researchers at the National Institutes of Health Clinical Center are conducting a research study to improve the understanding of Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI). If you have had a recent brain injury, please consider participating in this clinical research study.

This study may be done on an inpatient or outpatient basis. It will be conducted at the NIH Clinical Center in Bethesda, Maryland, which is located on the Metro Red Line. The study will involve eight visits over five years (four visits the first year after your brain injury, then yearly).

If you are between the ages of 18 and older, have had a brain injury within the last six months, and can have an MRI, you may qualify. Compensation is provided. All study-related tests are provided at no cost.
