

WANT TO HELP YOUR FELLOW WOUNDED WARRIORS?

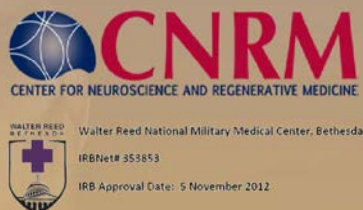
You may be eligible to participate in research if you are a service member who sustained any type of injury while deployed or stateside.
