

Would you like to take part in research studies to better understand TBI and PTSD? Both military service members and family members can enroll.



If you agree to enroll, we can tell you about a variety of CNRM studies at the National Institutes of Health, Ft. Belvoir Community Hospital and Walter Reed National Military Medical Center, that address TBI, PTSD, and related conditions.

You may be eligible if you:

- ▢ Are DEERS eligible, whether active duty, retired, or a family member
- ▢ Are 18 years of age or older
- ▢ Have signs and symptoms of TBI, PTSD, or are in good health

If you qualify:

You may be scheduled for an outpatient visit at Uniformed Services University in Bethesda, MD, Walter Reed National Military Medical Center or at Ft. Belvoir Community Hospital, for a physical exam, medical history, blood draw, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), and questionnaires.
