Enrolled participants can learn about a variety of CNRM studies which address TBI, PTSD and related conditions at the National Institutes of Health, Fort Belvoir Community Hospital and Walter Reed National Military Medical Center.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a DEERS eligible service member, retiree or family member.
- Are 18 years of age or older
- Have signs and symptoms of TBI, PTSD, or are in good health

If you qualify:

You may be scheduled for an outpatient visit at Uniformed Services University in Bethesda, Md., Walter Reed National Military Medical Center or Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, for a physical exam, medical history, blood draw, magnetic resonance imaging (MRI), and questionnaires.
